LEZ get ready

You may have seen our advertising campaign in Commercial Motor about the imminent changes to the Low Emission Zone (LEZ). Transport for London (TFL) too, have been warming us all up to the changes for a couple


of years now and clearly the message is starting to hit home. The bare facts are that any pre-Euro IV compliant truck will be charged £200 a day to travel within the LEZ.

On 3 January 2012, when Euro IV comes into force, TFL will start to apply charges to vehicle owners for driving Euro III compliant and older vehicles in the LEZ. If you haven't already seen how big the zone is, take a look at the map below. The LEZ covers virtually all of the Greater London area within the M25

and there is already talk of this being extended beyond the M25.

If you go into the LEZ at say 22.00 at night and then come out at 02.00 the next day (i.e. a total of just four hours), you will be charged twice, a bill of £400! And if you believe you won't get caught, think again. There are enough signs on the roads to give you advance warning you are about to enter the LEZ and as soon as you do, your registration plate will be picked up on camera. The cameras are linked to the DVLA database, your V5 and your address and your bill will be winging

its way to you before you even leave the LEZ. So unless, you can safely operate without going into London, you have to act now.

So what are your options? The first is to retrofit a carbon capture filter. These aren't cheap. A ring round the approved suppliers listed on the TFL website indicates that this would set you back somewhere between £4,500 and £5,000 per vehicle. Furthermore, the retrofit filter needs to be cleaned every 60,000 kms at a cost of £300. This could mean an additional £600 per annum on top of the capital cost of the filter. If your truck is an early Euro III then, in all likelihood, a retrofit is the wrong decision for you. The alternative is to buy a Euro IV or V compliant vehicle and at

Time for another change? It does feel like we've just started getting used to Euro V and now we're talking about Euro VI! It seems that the bureaucrats in Brussels can't leave the transport industry alone.

Across Europe, Euro VI will come into force at the end of 2013 ??

However Euro VI has been on the drawing board for some time. As far back as December 2008 Euro VI emission limits, to apply to heavy-duty engines, were agreed by the Council of Europe. The new standard will reduce emissions of nitrogen oxides by 80% and particulate matter by 66% compared to the Euro V limits. These are the most stringent reductions in emissions to date.

Across Europe, Euro VI will come into force at the end of 2013 for all new vehicles. In fact, most vehicle manufacturers have already launched a version of a Euro VI compliant engine, but it is unlikely that volume sales will happen any time soon. The significance of the new Directive is that the cost of new vehicle production has increased substantially to achieve this technical 'quantum leap' in emissions reduction. The higher production costs will have to be passed on to buyers in the form of higher prices for new vehicles. Inevitably there will be a rush by fleet operators, big and small, to buy the cheaper Euro V compliant models and it won't be long before



they are increasing in price too.
